

**Mathematics and Numeracy** following the 'New Heinemann Maths' scheme.

Multiplication - continue long multiplication

Division - written method of division

Decimals - written addition, subtraction and multiplication of tenths; concept of hundredths, written addition and subtraction of hundredths; concept of percentages.

Shape and Space - coordinates, line symmetry, 2D shape translations; position, movement and angles (turns of 30 & 45 degrees), different types of angles

Volume and Capacity - tenths of a litre, reading scales (up to 10ml divisions)

Problem Solving - solve mathematical problems focusing on using the strategies of reason logically, trial and improvement, and make a conjecture and test it.

## **ICT**

Digital storytelling:

Using Book Creator (iPad) to write instructions on how to make a paper aeroplane, including pictures.

Plan and shoot a series of short clips to make a short movie adding appropriate detail.

Find photos on school website, save and compile to make a collage of their time in Year 6.

Complete topic focusing on renewable energy and energy efficiency.

Vikings

Focus on the life of the Vikings - longhouses, clothing, food, Runes used for writing, language used, reasons for travel, longships, raiding and trading. Build a Viking longship using junk materials and test in water.

## **Other Information**

**Uniform –**

BOYS - Grey trousers, red school sweatshirt, grey polo shirt.

**Breakfast Club –** Open for all year groups from 8.00am. If attending, children must order breakfast e.g. toast/cereal. Parents are billed at the end of each month.

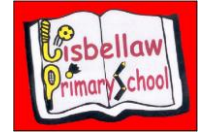
